#### ALUMNI & FRIENDS AWARD

Amount: \$500

Due Date: June 1<sup>st</sup>

Description:

This award is presented by the St. Catharines Collegiate Alumni & Friends Association to a graduating student who will pursue a post-secondary education at a community college.

Eligibility:

Recipient must:

- be a Collegiate grad, and must have attended the school for at least three years
- be proceeding to a recognized community college
- have contributed to the extra-curricular activities of the school and/or the community
- not receive any other award

Application Procedure:

Complete the 'Awards & Scholarships Application Form' and attach a brief outline of your contribution to school activities at Collegiate. Submit your application to the Guidance Department by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### COLLEGIATE STAFF AWARD

Amount: \$300 (x2)

Due Date: June 1<sup>st</sup>

Description:

These awards are presented by the staff of the St. Catharines Collegiate, to two graduating students, one male and one female, who have made a contribution to life at the school.

Eligibility:

Recipient must:

- be a graduate of the Collegiate and must have attended for the entirety of his/her high school education
- be proceeding to a recognized post-secondary institution (college, university, etc.)

Application Procedure:

Complete the 'Awards & Scholarships Application Form' and attach a brief outline of your contribution to school activities at Collegiate. Submit your application to the Guidance Department by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

The Sven Dohnberg Award

Amount: \$200

Due Date: June 1<sup>st</sup>

Description:

This award is donated in memory of the late Mr. Sven Dohnberg, trustee of the former Lincoln County Board of Education. Mr. Dohnberg was a supporter of the St. Catharines Collegiate and the ideals for which it stands. The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize a student who is a worthy citizen, has contributed to life at the Collegiate, and, despite hardship, has achieved a reasonable academic average.

Eligibility:

Recipient must:

- be a graduate of St. Catharines Collegiate
- must be proceeding to a recognized post-secondary institution (college, university, etc.)

Verification of registration is required. The award will be disbursed in September of the year awarded.

Application Procedure:

Complete the 'Awards & Scholarships Application Form', and attach a brief outline of why you feel you are suitable to receive this award. Hand this in to the Guidance Department by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
