Over the past few weeks, we have been telling you about our partnership with School Cash, an online portal that allows you to pay for any school service, product or event, all online. Starting November 7th, the system will be active and you can register any time by visiting our school website and clicking on the School Cash Online button.

Registration should take less than five minutes.

Register:

- Visit www.dsbni.org/schoolcash and select "Register Now"
- Complete the three registration steps
- **NOTE:** You must create your profile using *your name* and *not* your children's

Confirm Your Account:

- You will receive a confirmation email from School Cash Online
- Click on the link provided*
- Sign in to your account using your email and password



Add Student:

- This will connect your children to your account
- Confirm the school board name – DSBNI
- Select our school
- Enter your child's name and birth date
- Select continue
- Confirm your child and select continue
- Your child has been added
