FEES DUE AT REGISTRATION:

Student Activity Fee: \$40.00

Helps to offset the cost of student events and extra-curricular activities and access to the fitness centre (non-refundable after 60 days of attendance).

Graduation Fee: \$40.00

For all graduating students. Covers the cost of the cap and gown rental, portfolio, refreshments, grad decorations and grad photo sitting fee.

Yearbooks: \$40.00 (optional)

Orders for yearbooks can be taken at registration or throughout the school year for those interested.

All students will be assigned a locker the first day of school and are required to have a lock. Locks are available for students to purchase at registration or from the office during the first week of school for \$6.00.

STUDENT TIMETABLES:

The guidance department is looking forward to working with you during your time at St. Catharines Collegiate!

At the end of August, students will be able to access their timetables. Students can pick up their timetables in person on one of the registration dates.

Alternately, students will be able to view their timetable virtually. Instructions will be posted on the Collegiate website as of August 22, 2022. Students are asked to check their DSBN email accounts daily the week before school starts. In the event of a last-minute timetable change, guidance will send an email to students notifying them of the change.

Timetable changes will be prioritized for graduating students and for changes related to pathway planning. The link will be posted on the Collegiate website at the end of August.

HOOR REPUBLIC AND COMMUNITY HOURS:

We encourage students to fulfill the 40 hour community involvement requirement as early as possible in their high school career. The DSBN uses an online system, "Hour Republic" for students to submit and track Community Involvement Hours. Your child can access the link through the e-learning portal on our website. A computer lab will be available during registration week to create your account.
