Earlier this week, the Ministry of Education provided updates on the continuation of learning during the extended school closure period. They announced that schools would reopen for students on May 4th, depending on Public Health recommendations.

We hope that you have already been in contact with your teachers this week, whether it was through online classes, email or on the phone. Please check in with your online classes every day. You should also regularly check your DSBN email account, school website, DSBN website and social media for ongoing updates.

Teacher led learning will formally begin on Monday April 6th. You should be spending approximately 3 hours on assigned work for each of your courses per week. Your learning may include tasks, projects, culminating activities and these will be marked by your teachers for formative and summative evaluation.
