Daily Synchronous Learning– NEW!

While schools remain physically closed, students will be participating in daily synchronous learning. Starting on February 4th, it is very important that you log in to your class at the time **instructed by your teacher** to participate in your daily learning. There will be set times for about an hour at the start of each day and again at the end of each day of synchronous learning in Microsoft Teams or Google Classroom. Your teachers will reach out by email prior to your class to give you directions of where to login.
