Hello Students, Parents & Guardians!

We hope you are doing well and taking the time to enjoy some of this beautiful weather.

The DSBN will be running Summer School in the months of July and August. Students will have an opportunity to earn **new credits**, **recovery credits** or **upgrade credits**. Below you will find links to Google forms where you can begin the registration process.

Here are some details about Summer School:

- July session runs from July 1-27
- August session runs from July 28-Aug 23
- For the month of July - option of online or in person (Face to Face - F2F) pending approval from Public Health. In person runs from 8:30 am -2:40 pm
- For the month of August - online option only
- In person site schools - Sir Winston Churchill or AN Myer. Transportation provided.
- All courses are dependent on sufficient enrollment. You will receive notification if the course does not run.
- Students are expected to attend and be engaged on a daily basis in their chosen session. Please do not register for summer school if the student is planning summer vacation or has extensive time commitments with a job.
- Both online and in person require approximately 5-6 hours of active learning, Monday-Friday
